REGISTER AND PARTICIPATE!

Our future is in your hands too.



If you are citizen of the EU or one of the countries with a reciprocal agreement and you meet the necessary requirements, you have the right to vote in the coming municipal and European elections on 26 may 2019. You must be registered on the electoral roll to be able to vote!

WHAT ARE THE REQUIREMENTS?

- You must **be over 18** and not have been deprived of the right to vote
- You must be registered on the municipal census
- You must have a **Spanish residence permit** (only for non-EU nationals)
- You must have resided legally in Spain for at least 5 years at the time of the application (only for non-EU nationals) or 3 years on the day of the vote for Norwegian nationals
- You must **meet all the requirements** established in corresponding agreement

HOW CAN YOU REGISTER TO VOTE?

- Online at www.mont-roig.cat/es/elecciones
- In the offices of the Municipal Citizens Advice Service (OMAC)
- By post by returning the letter sent to you by the National Statistics Institute (INE) or at the INE in person

HOW LONG DO I HAVE TO REGISTER?



EU citizens have until **30 January** and other nationalities until **15 January 2019**.
